

Postdoc Position (m/f/x) in Accounting (100%, TV-L E14)

The TUM School of Management invites applications for a **postdoc position** on the **TV-L E14 level** (m/f/x) of the public sector pay scale at the Professorship of Accounting. The Professorship of Accounting (Prof. Dr. Michael Stich) is an integral part of the Global Center for Family Enterprise at the TUM Campus Heilbronn. It contributes to a wide spectrum of challenges related to accounting, e.g., financial accounting, managerial accounting, sustainability accounting, and tax accounting. The expected starting date is **April 01, 2022 or later** by mutual agreement. The position is limited to **36 months**. After a positive research and teaching evaluation, the position is extended for **another 36 months**.
