It contributes to a wide spectrum of challenges related to accounting, e.g., financial accounting, managerial accounting, sustainability accounting, and tax accounting. The expected starting date is **April 01, 2022 or later** by mutual agreement. The position is limited to **36 months**. An extension for **another 12 months** is possible.
